

## Cornwalls Meadows

### Proposal

To provide a safer route from the pedestrian bridge to the Cornwalls Meadow shopping area and onwards to the town centre.

The detail of the route from the bridge (see Fig4)

1. Extend the bridge footpath to the first parking bay which would be converted to a pedestrian area.
2. Lay a raised / ramped pedestrian crossing to the substation wall
3. Lay a 2 metre wide railed pedestrian path along the side of the substation
4. Provide a marked crossing point from the substation to the pavement outside the community centre

### Safety

The access to from the bridge to the town centre was adequate before the new carpark arrangement was installed but now with all the incoming traffic having to enter the car park via this road - it is a serious safety risk.
