
The pathway BUC/13/2 is open I am not sure how long it has been open but it was still blocked late last year.

This path link is excellent for walkers with the potential for an outer circular walk – just a few bits missing see Map 2 at the end of this document.

In Map 1 below there are 3 coloured arrows which indicated the location and direction that pictures 1 to 3 were taken.

The red line on Map 1 runs along the fence line of Lace Hill and is part of the BUC/13/2 path (it needs some foot fall to even out the surface). If you want to avoid crossing the Buckingham bypass to BUC/13/3 pathway and the Badgers estate then the blue line is an excellent path which continues along the fence line of Lace Hill on to the pedestrian traffic lights on the A421.

As they say in Rugby Union "use it or lose it" – in that case they are talking about the ball but in this case it is the pathways.





Pic 1 Red arrow




Pic 2 Blue arrow
